To explore the art of Chinese calligraphy as an art medium and to understand the structure of the character and historical of art in China.

Course Description

Interesting highlights of the programme include:

- Practice the Dot Stroke (step by step)
- Practice by copying from Samples or Copybooks, you will understand the balance of structures not only between a single Chinese character
- Understand how the stroke moves. Control the brush fast or slow using only the nib or the full brush hair.
- Participants will be able to write the proper strokes
